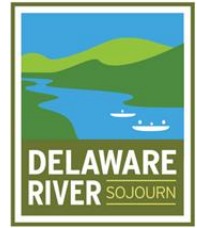

Giving Pond (RM 166) to Bulls Island, NJ (RM 155.6)
10.4 miles Class I- to I+ Rapids

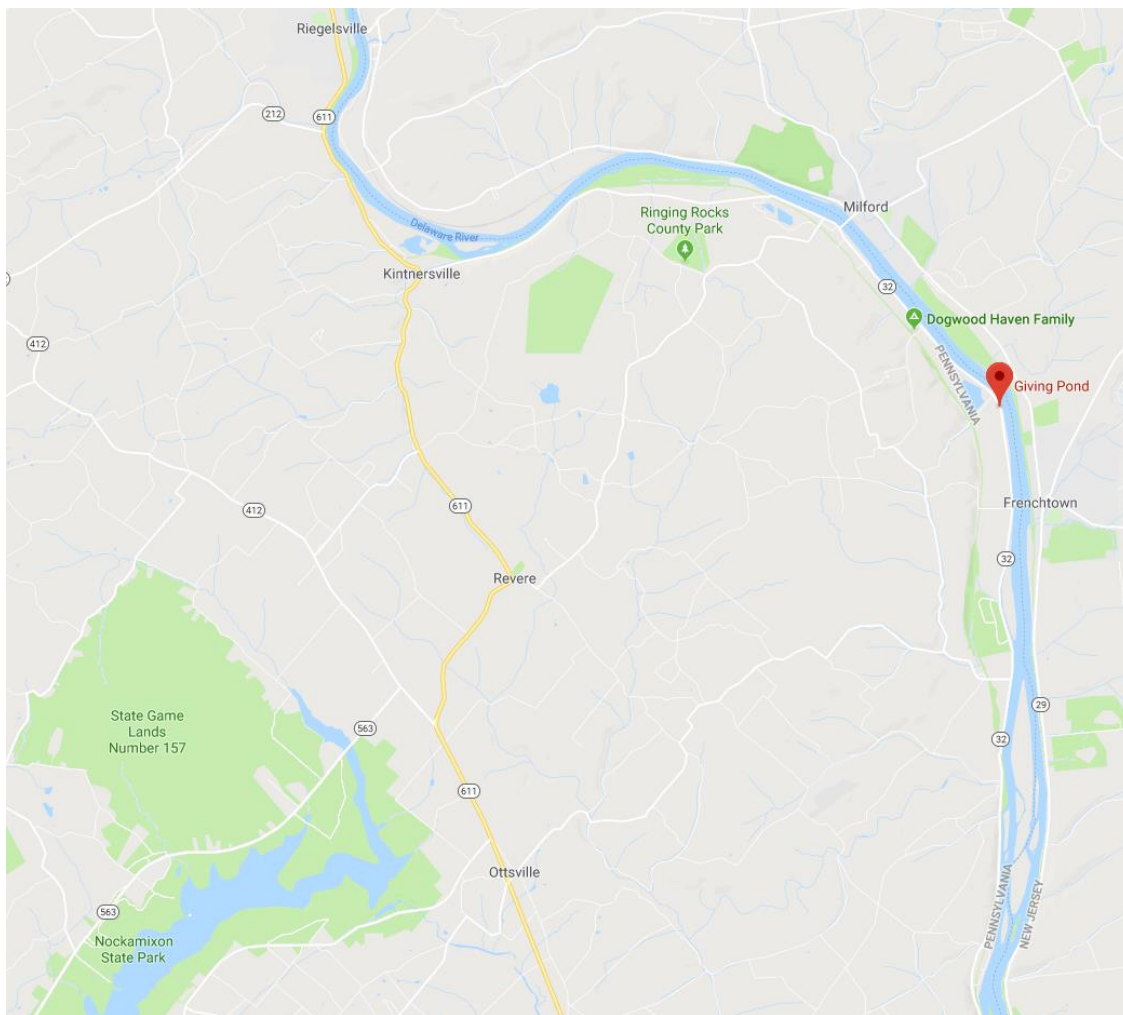

Directions to Giving Pond, 1125 River Rd., Upper Black Eddy, PA

Giving Pond Recreation Area is on River Rd. (PA Rt 32) between the Frenchtown, NJ/Uhlerstown, PA and Milford, NJ/Upper Black Eddy, PA river bridges. It is on the west side of River Rd, just south of the intersection with Jugtown Hill Rd.

Directions from Giving Pond Recreation Area to Burlington Quaker Meeting House Center for Conference

(NOTE: Parking is across High Street, behind the stores. Please bring your overnight gear to the Meeting House)

1. Head south on PA Rt. 32.
2. Turn left onto Bridge St./Uhlerstown-Frenchtown Bridge; enter New Jersey and follow Bridge St.
3. Turn right onto NJ-29 S/Trenton Ave.
4. Continue on NJ-29 S to I-295 toward Princeton.

5. Stay on I-295 to exit 47B, Burlington (Mt. Holly Rd, Rt 541).
6. Stay on Rt. 541.
7. Cross Rt. 130; road becomes High St.
8. Continue to the Meeting House, 340 High Street.
9. Parking access is on the right, across from the Meeting House.
