- Friday, June 16: Volunteer River Cleanup from Damascus, Pa. to Skinners Falls, N.Y. (camp opens at Northeast Wilderness Experience (NEWE), Equinunk, Pa.)
- Saturday, June 17: Hancock, N.Y. to Buckingham Access, Pa. (camp at NEWE)
- Sunday, June 18: Buckingham Access, Pa. to NEWE's Camp (camp at NEWE)
- Monday, June 19: NEWE Camp to Callicoon, Pa. (camp at NEWE)
- Tuesday, June 20: Dingman's Ferry, Pa. to Bushkill, Pa.
 (camp at Driftstone, Mt. Bethel, Pa.)
- Wednesday, June 21: Shawnee Inn, Shawnee on Delaware, Pa. to Driftstone (camp at Driftstone)
- Thursday, June 22: Driftstone to Martin's Creek Access, Pa. (camp at Driftstone)
- Friday, June 23: Martin's Creek Access to Phillipsburg, N.J. (no camping, Sojourn over)
