

• Monday, June 17: Bushkill, Pa. to Worthington (camp at Worthington)

 Tuesday, June 18: Worthington to Ramsaysburg Historic Farmstead, N.J. (camp at Worthington)

 Wednesday, June 19: Martin's Creek Access, Pa. to Phillipsburg, N.J. (camp at Washington Crossing, Pa.)
