Directions from Zane Grey Museum to West End Beach, Port Jervis, NY

West End Beach: 14 Ferry Street, Port Jervis, NY 12771

From Zane Grey Museum: Head south on Scenic Dr. (0.2 mi). Turn right to stay on Scenic Dr (0.2 mi). Turn left onto Delaware Dr/Roebling Bridge – enter NYS (0.2 mi). Turn right onto NY-97 S (21.7 mi). Turn right onto Grand View Ave. (0.3 mi). Turn right onto W. Main St. (0.2 mi). Turn left onto Ferry St. (0.1 mi).

Directions from West End Beach, Port Jervis, NY to Worthington State Forest

Worthington State Forest: Old Mine Road, Columbia, NJ 07832

From West End Beach: Head northeast on Ferry St. towards River Rd. (223 ft.). Turn right onto River Rd. (0.4 mi). Continue onto Water St, (0.1 mi). Turn right onto US-209 S/US-6 W/Pike St. Continue to follow US-209 S/US-6 W; pass by Citizens Bank (on the right) and enter Pennsylvania (6.8 mi). Turn left onto US-209 S/E Harford St. Continue to follow US-209 S (partial toll road, 27.9 mi). At the traffic circle, take the 2nd exit onto US-209 (3.2 mi). Keep left at the fork and merge onto I-80 E (partial toll road) and entering NJ (2.9 mi). Take the exit toward River Rd, (420 ft). Make sharp right onto River Rd. Follow Sojourn signage to camping area.

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
