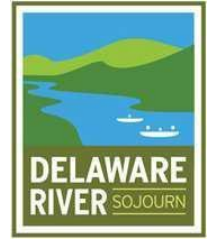

5+ Miles, Smooth Tidal Waters

Saturday Morning: Registration and breakfast at United Christian Assembly Church, 232 E. Front St., Florence, NJ; parking lot is located behind the church on Second St. All Sojourners meet and park here. [Use link to create your own directions.](#)

7:00 a.m. **Campers:** Break camp at Burlington Quaker Meeting House and pack vehicles. Drive to Florence United Christian Assembly Church, 232 E. Front St., Florence NJ. Park in the lot on 2nd St., behind the church. Folks who will be loading boats at the end of the day should take the spots closest to 2nd St. See directions on page 2.

7:30-8:30 a.m. Registration and breakfast at Florence United Christian Assembly Church

8:30 a.m. Bus shuttle to Bordentown, NJ

9/9:15 a.m. Safety briefing

9:45 a.m. Launch

11 a.m. Arrive at Quaker Penn Park. NOTE: boats will have to be moved up to the grassy area to the right since the launch will be used by boaters. Bus will shuttle us to Pennsbury Manor.

11:45 a.m. Tour of Pennsbury Manor. Prior to that, there is a film in the visitor's center that we can watch and an exhibit. Lunch will follow in the pavilion outside.

1:30 p.m. Bus will shuttle us back to the boats for launch.

2 p.m. Resume paddling.

3 p.m. Take out at Florence. We will walk to the church (2 blocks) for ice cream social and raffle.

From Burlington Quaker Meeting House: Head north on High St (toward the river, 0.2 mi.). Turn right onto East Pearl St. (2.3 mi). Turn left onto Neck Rd. and continue onto River Rd and W. Front St. (3.0 mi). Turn right onto Walnut St. to access parking lot behind the church.
