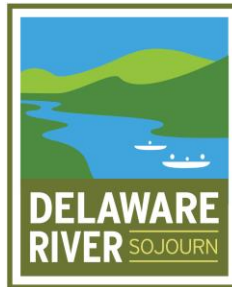




JUNE 14-22, 2019 DELAWARE RIVER SOJOURN

- Sunday, June 16: Zane Grey Access to Indian Head - Knight's Eddy, N.Y. (15 mi)
- Monday, June 17: Indian Head – Knight's Eddy to West End Beach, Port Jervis, N.Y. (7 mi)
- Tuesday, June 18: Dingmans Campground to Bushkill, Pa. (10.4 mi)
- Wednesday, June 19: Bushkill to The Shawnee Inn, Pa. (13 mi)
- Thursday, June 20: Bull's Island, N.J. to Lambertville, N.J. (7 mi)
