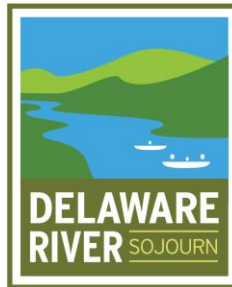




JUNE 19-26, 2020 DELAWARE RIVER SOJOURN

2020 Stretches to be Paddled/Camping:

- Friday, June 19: 1 PM to 4 PM Volunteer River Cleanup: Hancock, N.Y. area

Camp opens Friday Evening at Northeast Wilderness Experience (NEWE), Equinunk, Pa.
- Saturday, June 20: Hancock to Buckingham, Pa. (6 mi); camp at NEWE
- Sunday, June 21: Buckingham to NEWE Camp (13 mi); camp at NEWE
- Monday, June 22: NEWE Camp to Damascus, Pa. (14 mi); camp at NEWE
- Tuesday, June 23: Damascus to Narrowsburg, N.Y. (8 mi, through Skinner's Falls); travel to & camp at Driftstone, Mt. Bethel, Pa.
- Wednesday, June 24: Minisink Park, Brodhead Creek to Driftstone Camp, Delaware River (12 mi through the Delaware Water Gap); camp at Driftstone
- Thursday, June 25: Driftstone to Martins Creek, Pa. (9.2 mi through Foul Rift); camp at Driftstone
- Friday, June 26: Easton, Pa. to Riegelsville, N.J. (8.5 mi); no camping, Sojourn over
