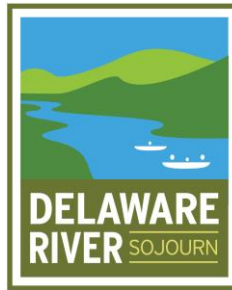

2022 Stretches to be Paddled/Camping:

- Friday, June 17: 1 PM to 5 PM Volunteer River Cleanup: Lackawaxen, Pa. area

Camp opens Friday Evening at the Zane Grey Museum Lackawaxen, Pa.
- Saturday, June 18: Ten Mile River, N.Y. to Zane Grey (6 mi); camp at Zane Grey.
- Sunday, June 19: Zane Grey to Knights Eddy, N.Y. (15 mi); travel to & camp at Worthington State Forest, N.J.
- Monday, June 20: Bushkill, Pa. to Worthington (13 mi); camp at Worthington State Forest.
- Tuesday, June 21: Worthington to Ramsaysburg, N.J. (10.6 mi); camp at Worthington State Forest.
- Wednesday, June 22: Riegelsville, N.J. to Giving Pond, Pa. (9 mi); camp at Tohickon Valley Park, Pa.
- Thursday, June 23: Tinicum, Pa. to Lambertville, N.J. (15 mi); camp at Tohickon Valley.
- Friday, June 24: Fireman's Eddy, N.J. to Yardley, Pa. (8.5 mi); camp at Tohickon Valley.
- Saturday, June 25: Delaware River, Bordentown, N.J. up the Crosswicks Creek & back (8 mi); no camping, Sojourn over.
